All fully elected members of the organising club and any members of the ARCC.
All competitors must produce a valid club membership card.
Entries are subject to the provisions of F9 for competitors who are age 15 or 16 years (or 17 & over without a full RTA Licence.

The event is not a round of any Championship
5. The programme of the event will be:

The first car will start at 10.00 hrs.
Any competitor not signed on by 10.00 hrs may be excluded.
6. The event will consist 3 classes:
 - 1 Imps and derivatives up to 915cc ie + 60th rebore.
 - 2 Imps and derivatives over 915cc. ie 930, 998, 1040 etc
 - 3 Imp based cars. Eg Clan, Davrian, Ginetta, Nymph etc

The organisers reserve the right to reclassify competitors according to B12.1.5. All vehicles must comply with MSA Technical Regulations E12 and F11.

e) Timing will begin when the leading wheels cross forward of the starting line.
f) The order of attempting the tests will be at the organiser's discretion.
g) Practising will not be allowed.
h) Competitors will be identified by scorecards, which will be provided.

D13 - Some markers may be less than 1m in height
A40 & C(a) 57 - Entries will be selected in order of receipt by the secretary of the meeting.
